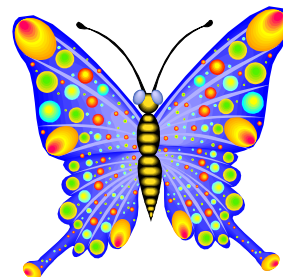

SCIENCE FACT FROM MS ZIOGOS

How do insects breathe?

An insect doesn't have lungs; it just has holes along the side of its shell. These lead to tiny tubes that branch out through its body.

Air flows down the tubes to the body cells, which pick out and use Oxygen. The cells give off Carbon Dioxide, which drifts back up and out holes.
