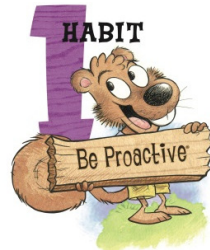


Parktone Primary School embraces a partnership with Franklin Covey to implement a Leadership program within the school community.

The Leader in Me provides students with an opportunity to develop their leadership skills by using the 7 Habits.

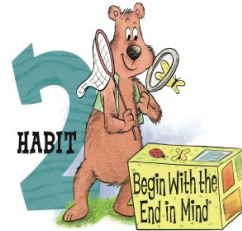

Write a shopping list.



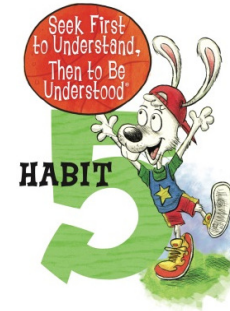
Prioritising to complete important tasks

Complete homework before play.



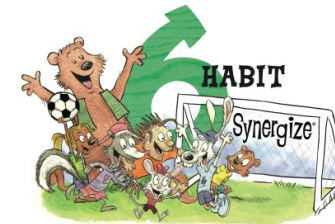
Compromising when a problem arises to promote fairness

Solve problems with a Win-Win outcome.



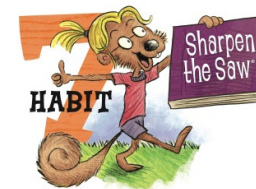
Listening to understand others before speaking

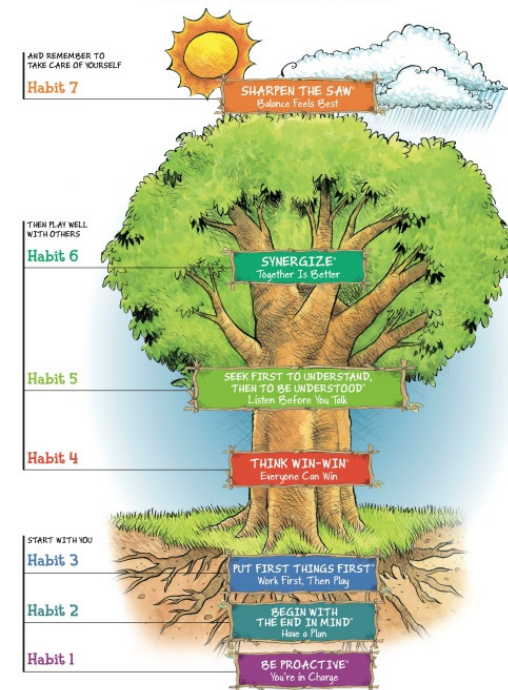


PARKTONE PRIMARY: A LEADER IN ME SCHOOL
